Jack: No thank you.

Alba: No thanks.

Jack: That's interesting. How often do you **go** to the cinema?

Alba: We usually **go** to the cinema three times a month.

Jack: What kind of films do you usually **watch**?

Alba: We usually **watch** comedies. Do you **like** going to the cinema?

Jack: I **love** going to the cinema! Would you **like** to go to the cinema with me next week?

Alba: Sure, that would be nice.

## Present Simple

1. We use the present simple to talk about: *facts, general truths, and permanent situations*



For example: a) *Jack comes from England.* b) *We live in London.* c) *England is in Europe.*

2. We use the present simple to talk about: *Routines, habits and hobbies*



For example: a) *Alba watches TV in the evening.* b) *Alba often goes to the cinema at the weekend.*

## Structure

(+) Positive I drink water. Alba drinks water. he/she/it = verb+s	(-) Negative I <u>don't</u> drink water. Alba <u>doesn't</u> drink water. Use <u>don't/doesn't</u> to make negatives (-)
(?) Questions <u>Do</u> you drink water ? <u>Does</u> Jack drink water ?	Yes, I <u>do</u> . / No, I <u>don't</u> . Yes, she <u>does</u> . / No, she <u>doesn't</u> .
(?) Questions *Verb BE Are you tired? Is Alba hungry?	Yes, I <u>am</u> ./No, I'm not. Yes, she <u>is</u> ./No she's not
(?) Open questions <i>Use Wh- words to ask for information.</i> When <u>do</u> you drink water ? Why <u>do</u> you drink water ? *Why are you tired ?	I drink water every day. I drink water because it's healthy. Because I work too much !
