

Guess the place!

This is a fun way to practice modal verbs of obligation, permission and prohibition with your students.

Instructions:

1. Start of by teaching/reviewing the modal verbs they will need for this activity.

Can	Ability, permission
Can't	Lack of ability, forbidden
May	Permission
Must	Obligation
Mustn't	Forbidden
Have to	Obligation
Don't have to	Not an obligation. You have a choice.

2. Clarify sentence structure

For example: You can't eat here.

3. Use one of the cards as an example. Ask the students to guess the place you are describing.

You have to whisper.

You may do research.

You can borrow books.

Where is it?

Answer: The library

4. Once the students have understood the game split them into pairs or groups, hand out the cut up cards from the worksheet and let them play!
