

## Jack and Alba: Asking Questions



1. It's Tuesday afternoon. Jack's mum, Emma, is calling him. Read the dialogue below and answer the following questions:

Emma: Hi Jack, it's your mum. How are you?

Jack: Hi mum, it's nice to hear from you. I'm good thanks. How are you?

Emma: I'm good. What is new with you?

Jack: Hmmm... I have a new girlfriend!

Emma: Oh really? How exciting! What is her name?

Jack: Her name is Alba.

Emma: Alba? That is an unusual name. Where does she come from?

Jack: She comes from Spain.

Emma: Interesting! How old is she?

Jack: She is 33 years old.

Emma: Does she live in London?

Jack: No, she doesn't. She lives in Kent.

Emma: I see. What does she do in Kent?

Jack: She is a primary school teacher.

Emma: That's nice. What is she like?

Jack: She is very funny and friendly. I think you'll like her.

Emma: I'm very happy to hear that Jack. She sounds very nice. I can't wait to meet her!



1. What do Jack and his mother talk about in this phone call? **His new girlfriend Alba.**
2. How many questions did Jack's mother ask about Alba? **6 questions. What is her name? Where does she come from? How old is she? Does she live in London? What does she do in Kent? What is she like?**
3. Does Jack's mother think that *Alba* is a common name? **No. She thinks it is unusual.**
4. How does Jack describe Alba? **Jack describes Alba as funny and friendly.**

## How to ask Questions in Present Simple

### Asking Closed Questions: Yes or No

DO + SUBJECT (*I, you, he etc.*) + BASE VERB + (...)?

Do you like chocolate?

DO S BV (...)?

Does she live in Spain?

DO S BV (...)?

Answers: Yes, I do. (*I, you, we, they*)

Yes, he does. (*he, she, it*)

No, I don't. (*I, you, we, they*)

No, she doesn't. (*he, she, it*)

### Asking Open Questions

WH- *Who, What, Where, When, Why, Which, How much (..), How many (..), How often, How*

WH- + DO + SUBJECT (*I, you, he etc.*) + BASE VERB + (...)?

Why do you like chocolate?

WH- DO S BV (...)?

Where does she live in Spain?

WH- DO S BV (...)?

Possible Answers: I like chocolate because it's sweet.

She lives in Barcelona.

### Using the Verb BE (am/is/are)

*Don't use the helping verb do to make questions and negatives with the verb BE*

Are they hungry? Yes, they are. / No they aren't.

*Why* are they hungry? Because it is late.

Is she in Spain? Yes, she is. / No, she isn't.

*Where* is she? She is in Spain.

3. Why **does** she drink coffee every morning?

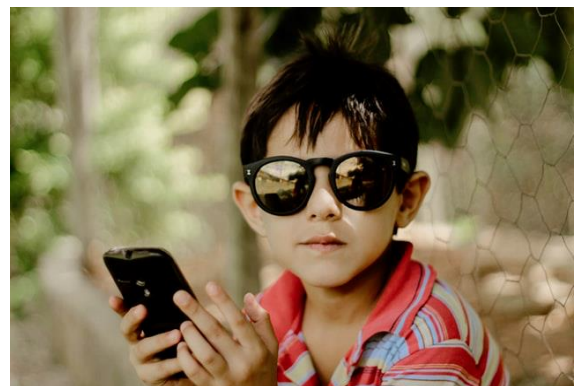
Because she needs it to wake up!
