Can

Use the modal verb “can” to talk about *ability*. Take a look at the examples below.

Positives: I can play the piano.
Jane can dance ballet.
We can speak three languages.

Negatives: Peter can't cook.
We can't swim.
They can't drive.

Questions: Can you speak English?
Can you play an instrument?
Can you bake a chocolate cake?

Short Answers: Yes, I can.
No, I can't.

This is the first time Anna is meeting Jack. Anna is very excited to meet Jack because Alba talks about him every day!

Alba: Hi Jack, this is Anna!

Jack: Hello Anna, I'm pleased to meet you.

Anna: I'm please to meet you too.

Jack: What would you both like to drink?

Alba: I would like a red wine please.

Anna: Me too.



Jack arrives with the drinks...

Jack: So, Anna where do you come from?

Anna: I come from Kent.

Jack: Oh, Kent! That's where you and Alba live. Kent is very beautiful.

Anna: I think so too but I would like to live somewhere else one day.

Jack: Oh really? Where would you like to live?

Anna: I don't know... Maybe Spain. Alba comes from Barcelona and she has many pictures of Barcelona in our flat. It looks very beautiful.

Jack: Cool. Can you speak Spanish?

Anna: No, I can't. But Alba can speak Spanish perfectly and she is a great teacher. She can teach me!

Alba: Yes, I can. I would love to teach you Spanish!

Jack: That's great. What do you do Anna?

Anna: I am a chef.

Jack: Wow! That is interesting.

Alba: Anna can cook very well.

Anna: Can you cook Jack?

Jack: Yes, I can but I am not very good. Maybe you can teach me how to cook one day!

Anna: Yes, of course! So, what do you do Jack?

Jack: I am a lawyer.

Anna: That's great. Do you like your job?

Jack: Yes, I do.

Anna: That's good. Do you like living in London?

Jack: Yes, I do. I love living in London. There are so many things to do.

Anna: You're right! There are so many bars and restaurants in London. There are more than *three thousand five hundred* (3500) pubs in London!

Jack: Wow! That's so many pubs! There are over *three thousand five hundred* (3500) pubs in London but The Red Lion is the best!

Anna: haha It is a very nice pub. What time does the pub quiz start?

Jack: It starts at 8:30pm. We should eat before the pub quiz. Are you hungry?

Alba: Yes, I am.

Anna: Me too! Is the food good here?

Jack: It's very good.

Alba: Jack always eats the same thing! Hamburger and chips! Always!
