Alba: I am going to wear a pink dress, a blue scarf, white shoes, a blue jacket and a pair of glasses.

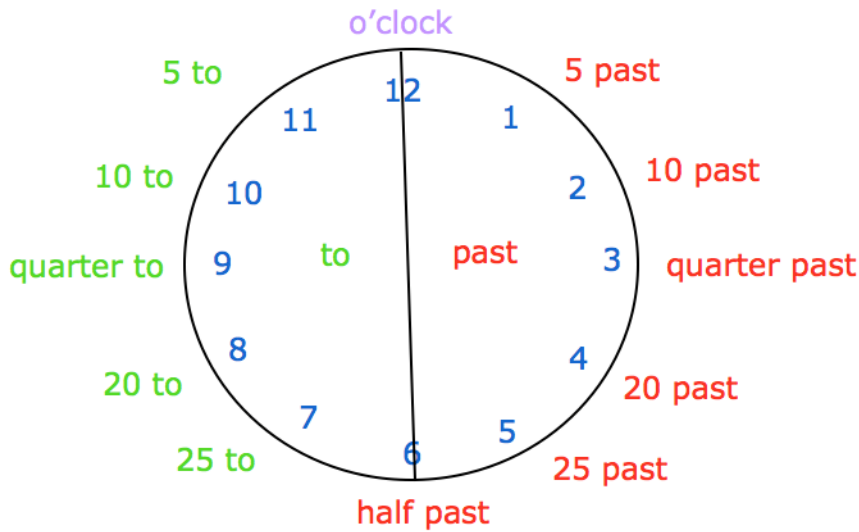
Jack: Ok, great. See you tomorrow at 7pm at Café Paris. X

1:00: You can say <i>'It's one o'clock'</i> or <i>'it's one'</i>
1:05: You can say <i>'five past one'</i> or <i>'one oh five'</i>
1:15: You can say <i>'quarter past one'</i> or <i>'one fifteen'</i>
1:25: You can say <i>'twenty-five past one'</i> or <i>'one twenty-five'</i>
1:30: You can say <i>'half past one'</i> or <i>'one thirty'</i>
1:40: You can say <i>'twenty to two'</i> or <i>'one forty'</i>
1:45: You can say <i>'quarter to two'</i> or <i>'one forty-five'</i>
1:50: You can say <i>'ten to two'</i> or <i>'two fifty'</i>
2:00 vs. 14:00 In English we don't usually use the <i>24 hour clock</i> (13:00, 17:00 etc.) We usually use the 12 hour clock with am (morning) and pm (afternoon and evening) or we use in the morning, in the afternoon, in the evening. 12:00pm (12:00) noon 12 am (00:00) midnight
