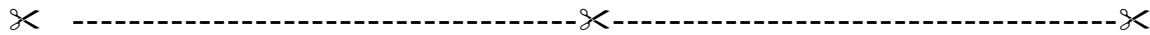


## Speaking: Past Simple

### Student A – *Past Simple*

1. What did you do last weekend? – Give a detailed description
2. Tell me about your last holiday. – Where did you go? Where did you stay?  
What did you eat? Who did you go with? Did you have enjoy it?
3. What was the last thing you cooked? – How did you make it?
4. Who were some of your favourite sports stars in the past?
5. What was the last movie or tv show that you watched? – Where did you watch it? What was it about? Did you like it?
6. Were weddings in your country different 100 years ago?
7. What did you do yesterday? – From when you woke up to when you went to bed.
8. What was the last book that you read? – What was it about? How long was it? Did you like it?
9. What was the last big thing that you bought?



### Student B – *Past Simple*

1. What did you do for your last birthday? – How old did you turn? Did you have a party? Where was it? How many people did you invite? What gifts did you receive?
2. What did you eat for your last meal? – Where did you eat it? Who cooked it? Was it good?
3. Tell me about where you grew up. – Was it a village, a town or a city? Did you live in a house or an apartment? Was it in the countryside (rural) or in the city (urban)?
4. Which bands were popular when you were young? – Which bands did you listen to? Did you have posters up in your bedroom?
5. What was your first job? – How old were you? What did you do? How much did you make/earn? Did you like it?
6. What things were different when you were a child in comparison to now?
7. How many emails did you send yesterday?
8. Did you do any housework last week? If so, what did you do?
9. Tell me about the last restaurant you went to. – Where was it? What was it called? Who did you go with? What did you eat? Did you enjoy it?
