Amy

I also prepare the coffee and tea section while the chefs bring out the food they have prepared. When the guests arrive I ask them for their room number and register them on our computer system. Then I take them to their table. The breakfast shift is quite easy because it's a buffet so I don't have to take any orders.

I have contact with the guests on a daily basis. The guests come to me for all kinds of information. I give them *tips* on the best local restaurants and *sights* to visit. Guests can find me just at the entrance of the hotel and I am always happy to help them with their *requests*. I often make bookings and reservations for them. I really like my job because I get to meet so many different people from all over the world and I love helping them discover the city where I grew up!

I work at the front desk. My job is to welcome the guests and register them into our system. It is important to be a friendly face when the guests arrive as often they are very tired from long journeys. As I am setting up their *key cards* I usually ask how their journey was and have some small talk. If guests have any problems they usually come to me and I *deal with* them. I try my best to keep the guests' stay as comfortable as possible.

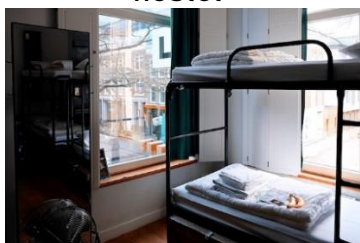

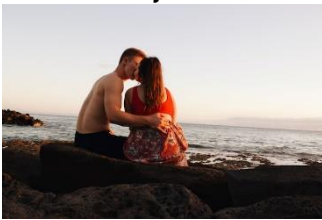
- Have you stayed in any of the types of accommodation above? If so, which one and how was your experience?
