



Quiz Game!

- Choose a subject and a difficulty/money level with your team.
- Your teacher will ask you a question. If you ask for a science question with a difficulty/money level of \$50, your teacher may ask you: *“What is the largest bone in the human body?”* If you answer *“femur”* or *“thigh bone”* or point to your upper leg and say *“this one”* you get \$50.
- Each team can ask a total of 12 questions (if there are 2 teams), and after that the team with the most money wins.
- You cannot choose the same subject and difficulty/money level twice (for example if the other team chooses a \$50 science question, you cannot choose a \$50 science question. Use the table below to keep track of which questions have been asked and how much money you have won.
