Baker: Great, that costs \$9.50.



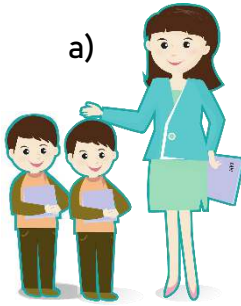
2. Complete the sentences below with "these", "that", "those", and "this."

- Those** is used for plural (more than one) things that are not near the speaker.

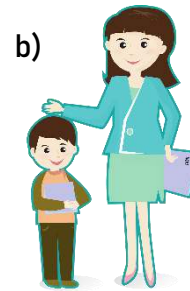
