The Present Simple

We use the present simple to talk about facts and routines.

The sky is blue. (fact)

I brush my teeth every morning. (routine)

We add “-s” after he, she and it.

She walks to work every day.

Negatives

Add "do not" (don't) before the verb for I, you, we, and they.

I do not (don't) play tennis.

For he, she, and it, we add "does not" (doesn't) + the verb (no “-s”).

He does not (doesn't) walk in the park.
