After my run, I go to the hospital. I walk past the supermarket. Sometimes, I buy food there. Then, I take the bus to work. The bus stop is near the hospital.

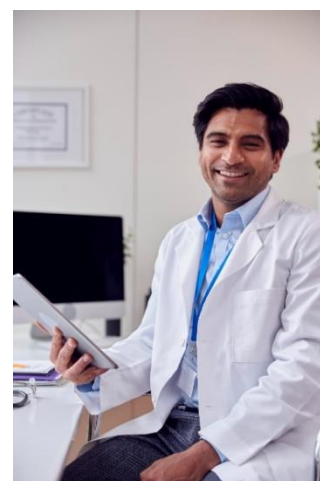
At the hospital, I see many patients. I talk to them about their health. Sometimes, I help them with medicine. Other times, I write reports.

For example: "You are learning English." (You are doing the action of learning right now.)

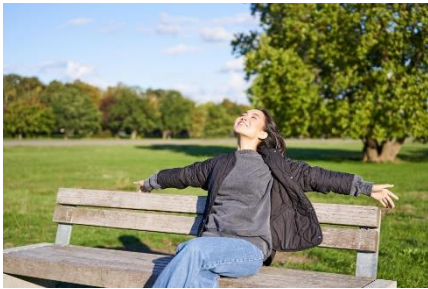

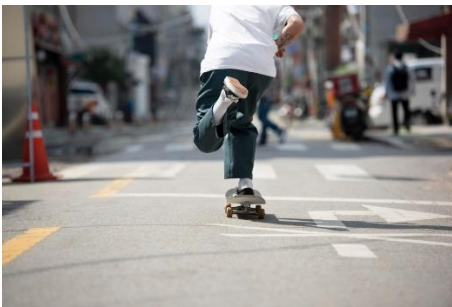

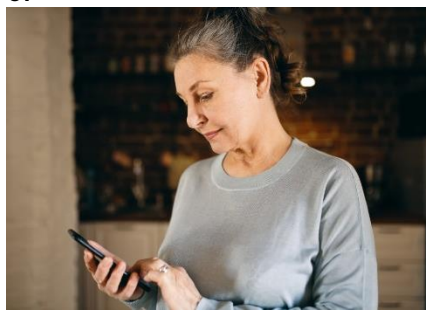
