Ava: Exactly! Total opposites — which is why it could actually be fun. Two styles, one party.

Jordan: I'm in. But we'll have to be careful — they don't just *like* different things, they *deal with* parties differently.

Ava: True. Leo hates being the centre of attention. Mia lives for it.

Jordan: Right. So, how about we create different zones? One chill, one louder?

Ava: Ooh, I like that. A gaming zone for Leo, maybe a dance area for Mia?

Jordan: That could work. But it might end up feeling like two different parties, and people will split up. We want them to mix.

Ava: Good point. What's our budget again?

Jordan: €700. If we go big on the venue, we'll have to spend less on decorations and extras.

Ava: Then why don't we start by choosing a space that gives us flexibility? Like somewhere we can decorate ourselves.

Jordan: Sounds smart. Let's also think about food early — Leo's all about pizza, and Mia's obsessed with sushi.



Ava: Ugh, why are they both so picky? Okay, let's find something that works for both — maybe one main dish and mini options?

Jordan: Exactly, we can think about what really matters to each of them and work from there.







THE HEAVENLY HAVEN

-  Downside: Can get crowded on the dancefloor








THE FUN FACTORY

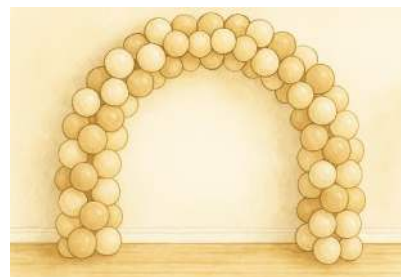
