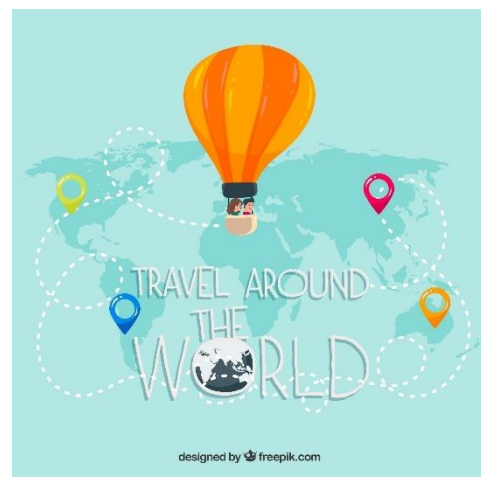

The First Conditional

We use the first conditional to talk about real or possible situations in the future.

→ Form: If + Present Simple, will + base verb. For example:

If I save enough money, I will visit six continents.

If she goes to Italy, she will eat pasta.

→ You can also change the order. For example:

I will visit six continents if I save enough money.

It will be cold if the sun doesn't come out.
